- If you or any of your family feel unwell or have Covid-19 symptoms please do not use the Leisure Centre for 14 days. If you become unwell after using the facility please contact the centre as soon as possible to allow staff to follow the government track and trace procedures.
- You do NOT need to wear a face mask.
- There are sanitising stations located throughout the centre, please use these often especially on entry to the centre.
- Once you have sanitised your hands and entered the reception area please give staff your name and the membership number off your card to prevent staff having to touch your card.
- Customers must adhere to the 2 metre social distancing guidance at all times.
- Doors will be left open throughout the centre to help with ventilation and to prevent touch hot spots etc.
- Signage will be up around the centre to remind customers of the government guidelines i.e. sanitise or wash hands regularly, social distancing etc. Please can customers adhere to all information on these signs.
- Unfortunately we are currently only able to accept cash for your fees, please try and bring the correct change.
- If your membership was in date on the 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020 when we closed for Covid-19, the days/weeks that you had remaining will be added to your first payment when you wish to return.

- We are unable to allow spectators for any activities, unless they are very young children or for certain medical conditions (please speak to staff prior to your visit).
- Toilet facilities will be available and regularly cleaned.
- Changing rooms and shower areas will remain closed at the moment, can all customers please attend the centre dressed appropriately for their session.
- Lockers in the corridor will be available for use to keep personal belongings in and will be cleaned after each use.
- You can book gym and class sessions up to seven days in advance by telephone or in person; currently a maximum of 3 gym and 3 classes per week will be available to be booked to allow more customers access to use the facility. This may be relaxed once we get an idea of customer usage.
- Gym sessions will be bookable for one hour with 15 minutes in between for staff cleaning of communal areas and to allow customers to leave site prior to the next customers arriving so that on site customer numbers can be kept within the Government guidelines of only 3 customers in the gym at any time.
- Please do not turn up for your booked session early as you will be asked to wait in the car park for your allotted time.

- Cleaning materials will be provided and customers will be expected to clean each piece of equipment they use before and after use.
- All types of equipment will be available to use but a few stations of the same equipment may NOT be accessible, so customers can adhere to the 2 metres social distancing guidelines.
- Water fountain in the gym is available; can all customers use their own drink containers.
- Hire of equipment is currently NOT available so please ensure you bring along all the equipment you require.
- Vending machines will be available for use; staff will clean these regularly and we ask customers to sanitise their hands before and after they use vending machines.
- Personal Training sessions are available to be booked and social distancing measures will be in place.
- All classes will be in the whole sports hall to allow for social distancing and ventilation. Please bring your own mats if at all possible and sanitise your hands regularly. All equipment will be cleaned after customers have used them. Not all classes will be as normal for a while so please look out for the new times or call the centre for more details.
- We request that all customers leave the centre once your session has finished to allow the next customers to enter for their session.
